

ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

- □ **Attend an Information Session**. This is an excellent opportunity to meet with program staff and alumni to determine if the program is the right fit.
- Begin the **online application** early. Applications are considered according to the following dates:

Round	Deadline
Round 1	December 1, 2023
Round 2	February 15, 2024
Round 3	April 1, 2024
Round 4	June 1, 2024
Round 5	June 15, 2024 (domestic only)

- Request transcripts from all previous college/university degrees granted. Applicants with degrees from non-U.S. institutions (see international transcripts information). Note: all transcripts uploaded by the applicant are considered unofficial. Official transcripts must come directly from your previous college/university to MSU.
 - Send e-transcripts (preferred method for domestic transcripts only) to: admis@msu.edu

- □ Update and upload your professional resume.
- □ **Identify, notify, and enter two professional recommenders.** These individuals will be automatically notified to provide their recommendations through a simple online form.

ADMISSIONS Checklist International Transcripts

Begin the <u>online application</u> early. Applications are considered according to the following dates:

Round	Deadline
Round 1	December 1, 2023
Round 2	February 15, 2024
Round 3	April 1, 2024
Round 4	June 1, 2024

- Request your transcripts early. <u>This process could take several months, so plan</u> <u>accordingly.</u>
 - Request transcripts from all previous college/university coursework.
 - <u>ONE</u> official/certified/attested university or professional school records of subjects and mark sheets, transcripts (list of courses taken, and grades/credits earned)
 - AND copy of diploma(s), and/or degree certificates; official document showing the below information:
 - Your full legal name
 - Name of institution
 - Degree earned/Major studied
 - Date degree was earned
 - Documents must be sent from the principal or registrar of each school you have earned a degree, or by the Ministry of Education in your country in a sealed envelope.
 - Photocopies or notarized copies are not acceptable.
 - When originals are not in English official translations must be furnished.
 - <u>Both</u> native language and English translations are required.
